Project Description:

Improvement of reading skills and thought to support the schooling system with the installment of a library, which can reach schools, orphanages, families and neighbourhoods surrounding Kpalimé and Agou. The goal is to reach children which have no access to the current municipal libraries, because they are too far away and do not have the time or the means to reach the nearest library. This institution shall also help to create an environment which is supportive towards exchange and linked to the participation in educational reading.

Work: Enter the school environment to promote in an informative manner the activities concerning reading and books, Read together with the children, Create animations and educational games concerning literature, Introduce books, Encourage parents to read to their children at home.

Requirements: Special abilities or qualifications are not required. If you like reading and are interested in literature and want to share your love for books, you can become one of the volunteers we are looking for.

Food: Provided by ASTOVOT.

Accommodation: Host Families.

Pocket money: None

Insurance: Volunteer has to get his/her own insurance.

Fees: 290 EUR per month. Administrative costs, costs for food and accommodation.

Visa: You need a visa to Togo. Information is available at the Togo embassy or consulate in your country. It is possible to obtain a visa at the airport but we recommend that you get in your country to avoid administrative complications.

Others: If possible, bring some manuals, gadgets or any educational material.
