Project Description:

Interaction in English with local students as a method to promote IVS and global education. Al Ishlah Schools are Islamic school located in the heart of Islamic Boarding School Al Ishlah Darussalam Semarang. Al Ishlah schools were established based on the need of formal education to the less students living around south Semarang area and especially those living in Al Ishlah boarding school in 1992. It concerns on peace and global education for all. Al Ishlah School is open for public especially for the neighborhood communities. Most students of Al Ishlah come from low economic family.

Work: Aims: To promote IVS and peace to students of Al Ishlah. To encourage confident of the students of Al Ishlah to interact in English with foreigners as part of global education. Works: Together with the staff member of Al Ishlah teacher, the volunteers will: 1. Assist English Classes with alternative subjects: Speaking, Cross Cultural Understanding, Global knowledge 2. Assist sports and art classes based on volunteers interests and skills and backgrounds 3. Organize activities to promote IVS values; 4. Organize English club or other language club. Note: 25 to 40 hours/week. Sometimes the volunteers are needed to support the

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school and/or GREAT to do other voluntary action during the weekends.

Requirements: Strong motivation in having interaction with teenagers. Online interview will take place during the application process.
