the river) and non-physical work (language class, learn traditional music instrument, organize an environment educational workshop, making coffee, organize english class, recycling class and cultural class) 25 to 40 hours/week. Food: Local food is provided by host family, mostly vegetarian

Accommodation: House of local people. Volunteers will share together sleeping space separately between females and males. Need sleeping bag. Sharing bathroom.

Pocket money: None

Insurance: Volunteer has to have at least health insurance during his/her stay in Indonesia.

Fees: 250 EUR per month. 40%:During LMTV (OAT,meals,accommodation,project materials,local transport, emergency) 60%:pre-post LMTV (need assessment,meeting with local partners,stakeholders)&donation to organisation: PV training, basic training, fees for IVS networks
